TOPIC FOR MAR. 5TH GENERAL MEETING

Many of you have gone with the Club to 10th Mountain Division huts in the summer, and learned a little about the famous soldiers that were part of it. The soldiers went on, years later, to found the skiing industry in Colorado. One of the byproducts of their efforts is the 10th Mountain Division Hut System where we have taken advantage of the opportunity to enjoy some of the back-country of Colorado's mountains. At the March General Meeting (March 5th) we will get to see three short films created by Gerry Case, a local photographer who was born in Boulder, that document three different years of visits to the Shrine Mountain Inn on the top of Vail Pass. They are a wonderful illustration of the phrase, "Roughing it in Luxury" as the three Huts known as the Shrine Mountain Inn, privately owned but managed by the 10th Mountain Division Hut System, are beautiful log structures where friends gather year after year to enjoy the scenery and ambiance of this location which is located just below the Continental Divide. We'll enjoy going into the huts with the group, climbing to the top of the Continental Divide, seeing beautiful sunrises, and viewing the comradery that this remote location affords to friends from all over the U.S. If you haven't enjoyed a winter trip to any of the huts you'll probably want to do so before this winter is over.

Annual FSC Canyonlands Moab Trip May 4-8 (4 nights)


